PROPOSITION 2: THE ABOLISHMENT OF THE SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY OF MEMPHIS FOR THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW AND EXPANDED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES PURSUANT TO SECTION 504.251, TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE (TYPE A CORPORATION UNDER THE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACT), CURRENTLY AT THE RATE OF 0.5 OF ONE PERCENT; AND THE ADOPTION IN PLACE OF SUCH ABOLISHED TAX, OF A SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF MEMPHIS AT THE RATE OF 0.5 OF ONE PERCENT TO BE USED FOR THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW AND EXPANDED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AND ALL OTHER PUBLIC PURPOSES PURSUANT TO SECTION 505.251, TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE (TYPE B CORPORATION UNDER THE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACT); ALL OF WHICH WOULD RESULT IN NO NET INCREASE IN THE SALES AND USE TAX COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF MEMPHIS.
