BE IT REMEMBERED THAT THE HALL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT REGULAR COMMISSIONERS' COURT MEETING ON September 11, 2023, with the following members present:

4. TAKE ACTION ON APPROVAL OF TAX RATE OF 0.7150 PER \$100 VALUATION OF PROPERTY FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2023 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2024.

Motion from Commissioner Wilson: I move that we approve a tax rate of 0.7150 per \$100 valuation which is effectively a 10.84% over the no-new

revenue tax rate of 0.659357 per \$100 valuation. This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operation than last year's tax rate of 0.7077. The tax rate will effectively be raised by 0.007300. The tax rate will effectively raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home approximately \$7.30. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Glover. Motion passed unanimously and It is the Order of the Court to approve the tax rate of 0.7150.

WHEREAS, hunger and poverty are issues of vital concern in Texas where 13.7% of people face hunger and one in every six children do not know where their next meal will come from; and

WHEREAS, everyone needs nutritious food to thrive, and in every community in America, people are working hard to provide for themselves and their families—yet in 2021, 34 million people—1 in 10—including 9 million children—1 in 8—faced food insecurity in the U.S. That includes 1 in 6 individuals and 1 in 4 children in Hall County; and

WHEREAS, the Hall County of Texas is committed to taking steps to combat hunger in every part of our community and to provide additional resources that those in Hall County need; and

WHEREAS, the Hall County of Texas is committed to working with High Plains Food Bank, a member of the Feeding America® nationwide network of food banks, in educating people about the role and importance of food banks in addressing hunger and raising awareness of the need to devote more resources and attention to hunger issues; and

WHEREAS, more than 510 individuals and more than 200 children in Hall County rely on food provided by the members of High Plains Food Bank annually; and

WHEREAS, the members of High Plains Food Bank distributed more than 6.5 million meals to 16,900 families in 2022 through its network of food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, and other community organizations; and

WHEREAS, the month of September has been designated "Hunger Action Month" in order to bring attention to food insecurity in our communities and to enlist the public in the movement to end hunger by taking action – including volunteer shifts, social media shares, and donations – to ensure every community, and everybody in it, has the food they need to thrive.

WHEREAS, food banks across the country, including the members of High Plains Food Bank – will host numerous events throughout the month of September to bring awareness and help end hunger in their local community;
