BE IT REMEMBERED THAT THE HALL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET IN A REGULAR COMMISSIONERS' COURT MEETING on November 16, 2020 with the following members present: Ray Powell, County Judge, presiding; Winfred McQueen, Commissioner Precinct #1; Terry Lindsey, Commissioner Precinct #2; Gary Proffitt, Commissioner Precinct #3; Troy Glover, Commissioner Precinct #4; and Olivia M. Duran, County Clerk. Also present were: Tom Heck, Hall County Sheriff; Ed Gentry, Hall County Sheriff Deputy; and Jerry Pasley.

The meeting was called to order at 10:01 A.M.

1. Opening prayer.

The opening prayer was led by Commissioner McQueen.

2. Approval of minutes of the Regular Meeting of October 13, 2020.
